

Supplement rules for 2009-2010 Winter Short Track

This is a supplement to the OMC rule book. All rules and classes not addressed here still apply.

General Racing:

It is up to the referee and finish line flagger for jump starts. Jump starts will be placed on the penalty line.

All races will be red flagged for two riders down in turn one or two on the first lap only. The rider causing the red flag will start from the penalty line on the restart. Once one lap is complete all restarts will be single file, wheel to wheel. Any atv race with a atv upside down will be an immediate red flag.

No beginners are allowed to run in open classes except open sportsman.

Classes:

ATV Expert:

- 1: 2-stroke or 4-stroke
- 2: All ATV's required to have a tether kill switch
- 3: All four tires must be class C type
- 4: Must have nerf bars
- 5: Main starts will be as many wide as track allows

Open Expert/Sportsman:

- 1: Must run dot tire on rear wheel
- 2: No front brake. Levers must be removed and not able to reach. (No taping levers to handguards)
- 3: Open displacement
- 4: Sportsman is a trophy class

ATV Open:

- 1: This is a trophy class for expert and amateurs.
- 2: Open displacement (Run what you bring)
- 3: No Mini quads
- 4: Knobbies or class c tires allowed
- 5: All ATV's required to have a tether kill switch

Pit Pike Pro:

- 1: Must run knobbies.
- 2: Must be a "pit bike" (no 65's trr 90 etc)
- 3: Must have 5 riders to have payout

Super Mini:

- 1: Ages 7-15
- 2: 2 stroke engines 86-112cc
- 3: 4 stroke engines 150cc
- 4: Minimum rear wheel size 14"
