Family Membership - \$180.00 per year
40-work hours per year

Single Membership - \$100.00 per year
20-work hours per year

\$700.00 Non working Single Membership per year

\$1200.00 Non Working, Family Membership (new this year)

Plus \$15.00 per card

You must be in college and under the age of 23 to be included in a Family Membership or on a Non-Working membership with your family.

Single memberships are for a single individual 18 and over and not in school.

- To be a member of OMC you must attend three meetings or two meetings and have $\frac{1}{2}$ of your hours in. All members need to fill out our membership form and pay their dues in order to have membership cards activated.
- Membership re-newel is to be done every October! Membership re-newel can be at a club meeting. If you have, any questions on Membership please contact Crystal Odom. (Use membership link on website.)

- Remember Members; you are not allowed to bring non members up to the club to ride unless it is a race day or an open water practice. Non compliance with this Rule will cause you to be suspended from OMC.

Membership Hours

To have your hours count towards your membership you are responsible for filling out an hour voucher. These vouchers are in the Club House for hours worked on workdays and also at races. If you are working at the club on a non work day or a non race day please get with a Board Member or Care Taker to fill out the voucher. When filling out the work hour voucher please make sure that you print legibly. Your hours cannot be documented if we cannot read your writing.

A Board Member must sign off all hours.

Single Membership	20 Hours per year
Family Membership	40 Hours per year

Half of your hours have to be completed by July. If half your hours are not completed by July then your card will be shut off until the hours are made up.

All hours must be completed by first meeting in October to eligible to vote for the next years Board and be in good standing for the next year. This means your card will not work if you do not have your hours in.

There are many ways to earn your hours, for **example**:

Flag at Races

Score at Races

Pick up Trash

Show up for workdays

(The day before any race the track is closed for a work day)

Pull Weeds

Empty Trash Barrels

There will be a list posted on the outside of the Clubhouse with a list of things that need to be done for the club or you can get with our groundskeeper.

Make sure that after you work you fill out a work hour voucher!!

You are responsible for your own hours.
